Four existing members of CWO started welfare work on a small scale. Initially team collects money from friends and relatives and distributes to various welfare organizations. Ironically there were no transparency procedures found in these organizations to select needy people. Therefore team planned to dispense welfare on their own.

To materialize the idea team consisting of 10 members of diversified background was formed and registered a trust with the name of “CRADLE WELFARE ORGANIZATION (CWO)”.

Cradle Welfare Organization aims to undertake community development and to promote the interest of poor and deserving by improving the provision of basic health and education facilities.

- **Number of Hand Pumps Installed: 202**

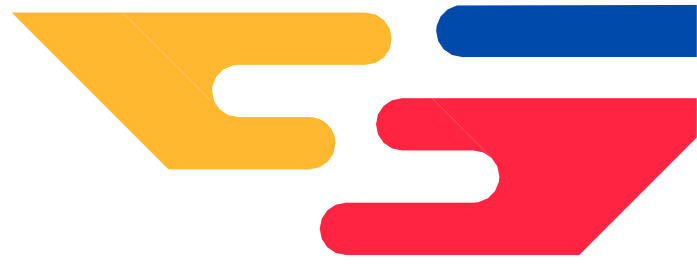

QURBANI:

CWO received overwhelming response in Qurbani 2023

- **Animal Sacrifices Made:** 44 (Cows & Goats)
- **Meat Distribution:** Approximately 1,000 families
- **Impact:** Provided fresh and hygienic meat to needy families during Eid-ul-Adha, promoting social and religious cohesion.



Dar ul Mustafa Ideal School:

Donation of School has been increased by 16% in 2022–2023

- **Enrollment:** 183 students
- **Educational Facilities Improved:** Renovation of classrooms, computer labs, provision of school supplies, and teachers training. etc.
- **Achievement:** "In 2023, a notable achievement was the successful matriculation of 12 of our dedicated students"
- **Impact:** Enhanced the quality of education and improved the overall learning environment for students.

Iftar Dastarkhan:

- **Iftar Meals Served:** 4,000 (Approx)
- **Beneficiaries:** People observing fast during Ramadan
- **Impact:** Provided nutritious meals for those in need during the holy month of Ramadan, fostering a sense of community and solidarity.

Ration Distribution:

Donation on Ration has been increased by 10% in 2022–2023

- **Families Assisted:** 10
- **Ration Packs Distributed:** 120 (Approx)
